Aiken, SC - December 17, 2010 - The Salute to Driving fundraising event that is being held in Aiken, and Windsor SC, February 19-21, 2011 will benefit this country's High Performance Driving programs. In addition to supporting the USET Foundation, the Salute to Driving event is being held to help raise awareness and educate different audiences about the discipline of driving.

The fundraising dinner and auction for the Salute to Driving will be held on Saturday, February 19, at Wendy O'Brien's Trout Walk Farm in Aiken. The affair will get underway at 6:30 p.m. with a beautifully catered dinner and full bar. Guests will have the opportunity to bid on fabulous items during the live auction. Some highlighted items include Brunch at the Green Boundary Club, two lessons with top driver Michael Freund at Sunshine State, Little Everglades or Live Oak, a dinner for eight presented by Jack Wetzel at his new log cabin, a week long vacation in a large Victorian Home on the beach in Cape May, NJ, and a Print "Patriots Barn" by Jamie Wyeth, signed and remarked by the artist. Throughout the night there will also be over 20 raffle items available including a photo shoot and dancing lessons.

Over the course of the weekend, other activities include driving clinics in Windsor, SC, held at three adjoining properties: Courage To Lead Farm owned by Beverley Leshner, Chateau Log Farm owned by Lisa Singer, and Suzy Stafford's new equestrian property. World-renowned trainer Michael Freund of Germany will lead the advanced level clinics, while talented trainer Larry Poulin will teach the lower level clinics.

On Monday, February 21, the Salute to Driving weekend will wrap-up with a thrilling Combined Test Competition open to all. Drivers will have the opportunity to compete in different divisions based on their skill level, complete with an awards ceremony. Throughout the day, there will be numerous demonstrations and displays such as displays of antique carriage and championship videos to help educate spectators on the ins-and-outs of Combined Driving. During lunch, there will be a wonderful Pas de Deux dressage demonstration featuring Phillip Dutton (under saddle) and Shelly Temple driving her National Champion pony. Several other activities to help guests better understand combined driving will be on going throughout the day.

The Salute to Driving has been spearheaded by Lisa Singer, Wendy O'Brien and Beverley Leshner, as well as many others involved with the driving community. "Our goal is to help educate and inform other disciplines and the general public about the sport of driving," commented Leshner. "The reason we are working hard to raise funds is because our particular sport is one of the smaller disciplines that holds World Championship competitions. It takes a lot more, even if you're driving a single, in terms of equipment and the cost to get to the event. Our goal is to continue to help fundraise so we are able to send our best and brightest competitors to the World Championship events. Sometimes people do not have the wherewithal to be able to handle the cost to ship a horse and all of the necessary equipment to Europe. We want to make sure, regardless of their financial position, that our discipline is sending the best representation for the United States."

The Salute to Driving weekend will be the can't miss event of 2011. With a beautiful dinner, expert clinics, and an exciting competition the Salute to Driving will surely be a weekend full of non-stop entertainment. 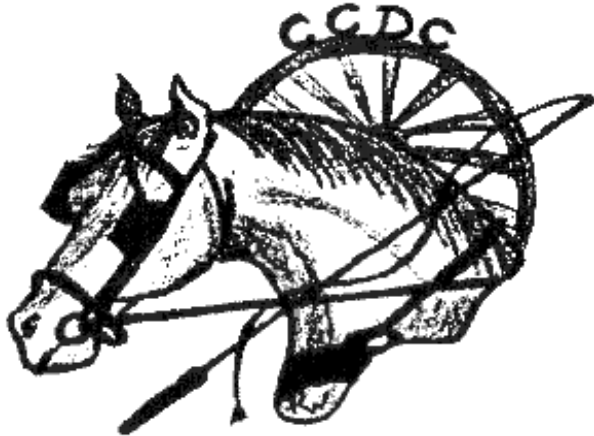

ADS members who enjoy recreational driving will be able to earn recognition for time spent in its pursuit, with the start of the ADS Hours to Drive Program which began April 1, 2008. The program, which will operate on the honor system, is designed to be a simplified version of the old ADS "miles program" for recreational drivers. You drive your horse or pony and write down the number of hours, on the log sheet spent on the box seat that day.

Drivers can earn an "Awards Pin" for 100 hours, 250 hours, 500 hours, 750 hours and 1000 hours of cumulative driving, by completing a log form. Logs must be returned before November 30, so we can report on members who have reached a milestone in the Whip and on the Web site.

Youth can earn credit towards an end of the year [Youth Recreational Championship](#) award.
